Number of Players are Unlimited

The CueSportz.com team have developed a tournament format designed to accommodate an unlimited number of participants from around the world.





4 Days To Complete a Weekly Tournament

Our weekly tournaments take 4 days to complete.

Let us start by explaining how the first 3 days of play works with approximately 10,000 participants.

This is Joe Black! He has just entered one of our weekly tournaments.





Play at a Time Convenient to You



Joe Black would be required to win 6 matches to make it to the final day of play.

On day one Joe Black must win two matches and he will have 22 hours to play and complete these matches.

Joe Black can play both matches one after the other, or space them apart, so long as he finishes his matches in the 22 hour given period.



How do I find an opponent?

When Joe Black first joins a tournament he will automatically be placed in the waiting room.

When he decides to play his first match Joe will enter the tournament room where he will be matched by another player entering the tournament room.





Winning a Match by Forfeit



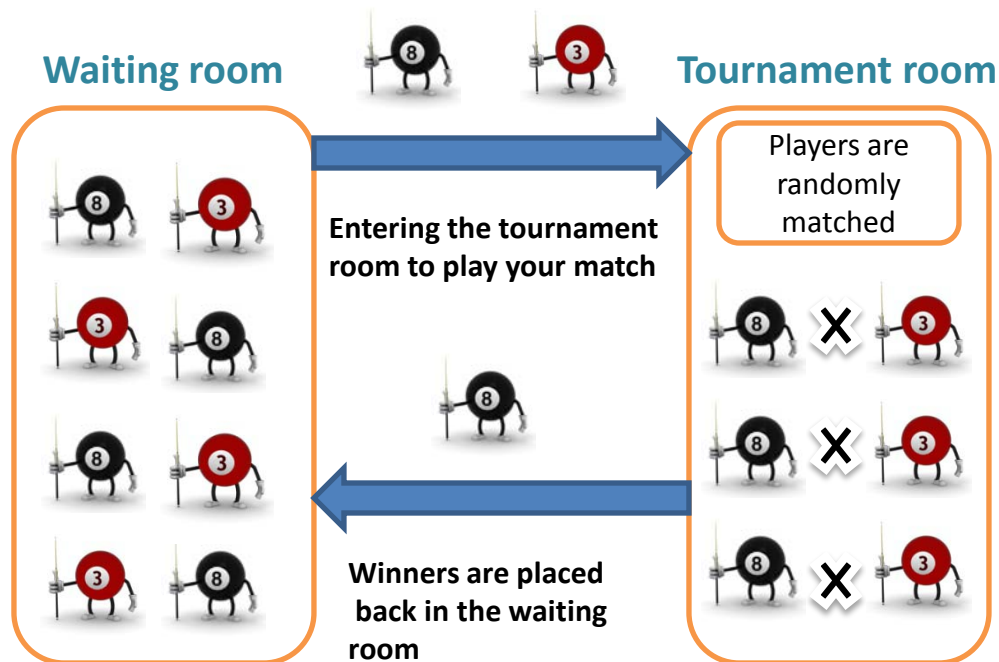
If Joe Black cannot be matched within 5 minutes he will be awarded the match by forfeit. If Joe wins the match or gains a forfeit he will automatically return to the waiting room.

Joe then plays his next match when he wishes, so long as he completes his daily matches inside the allocated 22 hour period. The same rules apply on day 2 and 3.

Waiting & Tournament Room



Below is a diagram of how our tournament system works on days 1, 2 and 3



On day one Joe Black enters the tournament room to play his first match. After the match Joe is the winner and he will automatically go back into the waiting room until he wishes to play his second match.

The same rules apply for day 2 and 3. If Joe wins all six matches he will then advance to day 4 which then becomes a fixed draw.



Last day fixed draw format

“Joe Black has won all 6 matches and has made it to the last day where he is guaranteed prize money”



On the last day a fixed draw will be generated with those who have qualified from the first 3 days. Naturally there will be byes in round one to leave us with a final draw of 128 players.

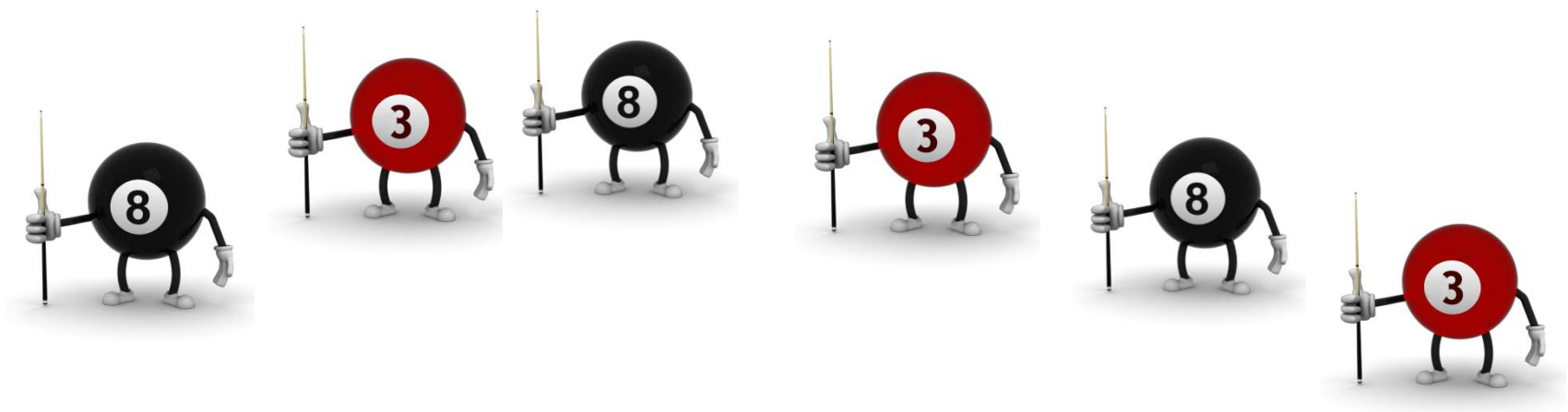
One hour will be set aside for each round until the tournament ends.

All players who make the final day will receive prize money.



More Players Means More Rounds

The example shown here has been for around 10,000 concurrent players. The amount of rounds on all days can change as the number of competitors grow. The more competitors the bigger the weekly prize pool.





Example of unlimited participants

Participants	Day 1 Matches	Day 2 Matches	Day 3 Matches	Final day Fixed draw Matches
10,000	2	2	1	8
100,000	2	2	3	10
1,000,000	3	3	3	11
2,000,000	3	3	3	12
